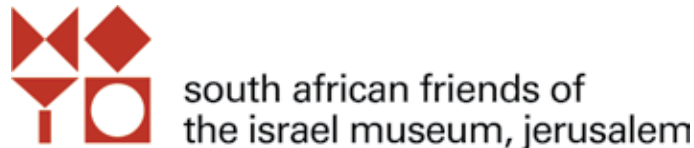
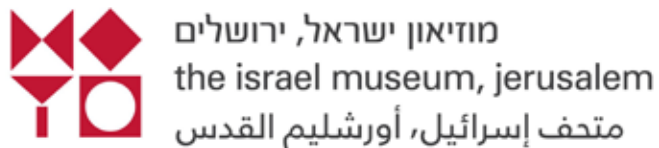


SOUTH AFRICAN ART JOURNEY

Visit to CIRCA Gallery or Everard Read Gallery in the city.

This afternoon - Woodstock Art shuttles/walk, before we return to the hotel. Gordon Rodowsky will be on site to showcase unique Bead & Jewelry Collection.

Following lunch, we proceed to the Dylan Lewis Sculpture Garden. Introduction by Dylan Lewis and walk around the Garden.

Return to the hotel, where you visit the One & Only Gallery and meet students from the Lalela Project for a Heart Map Workshop.
